EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Schedule regulates the application of rules to aircraft together with airspace users and the compliance thereof. It regulates aircraft within and registered in Malta. It sets out a legal framework regarding permissions granted by the Director General of Civil Aviation together with the use and misuse of signals and markings within the aerodrome. It also imposes regulations and obligations on the commander of an aircraft. The amendments proposed to the Thirteenth Schedule are based on the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 923/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of the 26th September 2012 laying down the common rules of the air and operational provisions regulating services and procedures in air navigation.

This document is the Government Response to this consultation and sets out the Government's decisions on these matters.
